**Yobet.com Augments Online  
Wagering Security with RCIIS Program**

Lexington, KY – RCI Integrity Services, Inc. (RCIIS) today announced that it has entered into a contract to provide wagering security services to Yobet.com, Inc. (NASDAQ:UBET), the nation's leading online pari-mutuel wagering company.

The RCIIS program will augment Yobet's already substantial wagering security systems, giving the advance deposit wagering company's retail and commercial customers an added level of protection against wagering fraud and other activities that could compromise pari-mutuel wagering pools. The program is expected to commence in June 2007.

"Yobet has been at the forefront on the issue of wagering security," said RCIIS Chairman Ted Connors. "With this agreement, they are taking the lead again by adding a layer of independent monitoring from RCIIS that will serve to strengthen their own protections.

"Yobet.com was the first racing industry company to show interest in RCIIS' effort to make the US pari-mutuel wagering system more secure through an independent monitoring service with automated alerts ... and now they will be the first to deploy it," Connors said.

"Our business relies on systems that the public can trust to protect their financial interests," said Yobet CEO Charles F. Champion. "That's why the industry needs levels of security that incorporate best practices, independent monitoring and regulatory oversight. Joined with our own best practices oriented program, RCIIS' system offers an important dimension of independence which, when operated in conjunction with appropriate regulatory authorities, will give our customers an incremental level of assurance in the integrity of our wagering products."

"It's a move that we'd like to see the entire racing industry emulate to help enhance protection for our pari-mutuel businesses and customers," Champion said.

**RCIIS Background:**

In December, 2005, the Board of Directors of the Association of Racing Commissioners International voted to set a deadline, March 31, 2006, on the racing industry to address its wagering security problem, brought to light by the infamous 2002 Breeders Cup Pick 6 larceny. That deadline passed with little progress. After

a committee of the NTRA formed to address this issue was disbanded in October, 2006, the RCI, at the request of its President Ed Martin, voted to create a not-for-profit subsidiary that would provide a national wagering security program and database, independent from any entity with a financial interest in the sport. The RCI Board authorized Martin to develop a business relationship with ESI Integrity, Inc. and the wagering security consultant who had been retained by the NTRA in the aftermath of the Breeders Cup Pick 6 scandal, Isidore Sobkowski.

In the spring of 2006, RCI Integrity Services was formed as a not-for-profit service provider and subsidiary of Racing Commissioners International (RCI) to combat wagering system fraud through a national program of independent monitoring and fraud investigation.

Soon afterward, RCIIS entered into an exclusive arrangement with ESI of Vancouver, British Columbia to offer ESI's Integrity pari-mutuel monitoring system in the United States. As part of that arrangement, the ESI Integrity system was to be enhanced by the fraud detection software MonitorPlus, developed and adapted to the pari-mutuel wagering system by Aprecia, Inc., a company founded by Isidore Sobkowski.

"The wagering security system once envisioned by the NTRA is now a reality," said Connors, noting that the development of MonitorPlus took most of calendar year 2006 and has been tested since under an arrangement with the Nebraska Racing Commission.

The ESI Integrity software has been in use since 2002 by the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency (CPMA) to monitor pari-mutuel wagering pools throughout the Provinces of Canada.

In the Summer of 2006, RCIIS was also authorized to enter into a relationship with Gaming Laboratories International (GLI), a world leader in the testing of electronic gaming systems, including pari-mutuel systems. GLI is presently working with several regulatory jurisdictions to assess needs in this area.

RCI President Ed Martin noted that the RCIIS system and program has received support from the National HBPA as well as the National Council of Legislators from Gaming States. Martin said it is his hope that racing companies will voluntarily sign on to have their systems independently monitored. He noted that some racing regulators, like those in New York, Colorado, and Indiana, have publicly expressed an intent to require monitoring. Martin predicted that lack of movement on the part of the industry would invite additional regulatory jurisdictions to impose monitoring requirements.

"Having Youbet voluntarily purchase and deploy the RCIIS security program is a key step in the process," Martin said, "because, as an acknowledged leader in this area, they are helping to set an example for the rest of the industry to follow."
